StandICT.eu just launched its 8th Open Call on "Resilience and Green Transition". This call offers the opportunity for European experts to request direct funding for their contributions in international ICT Standardisation organisations, work groups and technical committees.

The OC#8 online applications can be submitted until the **7th of November 2022 (17:00 CET)**. Individual professionals & experts contributing to standardisation in the chosen horizontal ICT fields (cloud computing, IoT, 5G, Cybersecurity and data) or diverse vertical ICT fields (AI, Industry 4.0, eHealth, Quantum technologies etc.) can request **up to 10K€ of direct funding** and **for a max. project duration of 6 months**.
